



Why do we invest in personal and social skills?

By consensus, labor markets and societies demand greater levels of adaptability and responsibility from individuals.

Never before have individuals been so technically prepared to perform specific functions and the mismatch between these qualifications and the ability to anticipate and adapt to the future was so evident (OECD, 2019; OECD, 2018; UNESCO, 2016).


Considering the unpredictability of the future of work and the fact that routines associated with the activation of cognitive skills are increasingly being replaced by automation systems, there is a growing need to identify **transformative skills** that respond to the needs of innovation and responsibility that the job market requires.

In 2018 CRPG started to develop two parallel programs:

- RACB a program focused on the development of basic skills (literacy, numeracy, digital literacy and leraning to learn);
- CPS a program focused on the development of personal and social competences.

FORTE - Formação, trabalho e emprego

(=Strenght - Training, work and employment)

As a result of:

- Demands of the employment market regarding personal and social competences;
- Soft skills are widely considered transversal skills that enable to perform professional functions in support of other professionals, who do not require specialized technical knowledge;

CRPG developed FORTE training framework, a trial experiment curricula that aims to promote personal and social skills, including digital skills;

FORTE is an individualized training course, started in November 2020, aimed at people with functional diversity associated with disabilities who, due to their functional profile, see access to qualifying training being restricted.






Examples of FORTE's training units

- Laboratory for Change | Main objectives:
- Develop mechanisms to identify potential causes of stress in the workplace.
- Identify and assess the degree of vulnerability to stress.
- Identify tools for better stress management.
- Develop flexible and creative response mechanisms in difficult situations.
- Identify means of assertive action in conflict situations, as well as enhance other constructive behaviors.

Conflict Management Game


